Tenders may be submitted electronically or in hard copy. Tenders submitted in hard copy shall be sealed in an envelope which shall be clearly marked as 'RFT2022-08 for Concession Road 3 Improvements' with bidders name and address, will be received by the Township of Mapleton, **7275 Sideroad 16, Drayton, Ontario, N0G 1P0**, until **2:00 p.m.** local time, as recorded by the Township of Mapleton on the date and at the place of tender, on

August 25, 2022

for the construction of the works described below.

Following electronic submission and upon notification of a successful bid, bidders shall submit one hard copy of their submission on the Bid Forms provided, signed and in a sealed envelope that clearly indicates the bidders name and tender number. Tenders must be legible, written in ink or typewritten.

On the same day, commencing at 2:05 p.m. local time, the tenders will be opened and read publicly by the Township of Mapleton, at the above-mentioned address.

The work consists generally of the supplying of materials, labour, and equipment for the improvements to Concession Road 3, including:

- Pulverise existing asphalt - 50,030 m²
- Granular 'A' - 9,224 tonne
- HL 4 Asphalt - 7,500 tonne
- Provisional Item to Remove and replace existing culverts - 2 each

Each tender must be accompanied by a tender deposit in the form of a certified cheque or bid bond in the amount of **\$40,000.00**, made payable to the Township of Mapleton.

Tenders are subject to a formal contract being prepared and executed.

The Tenderer agrees that the Township has the right, at its own discretion, to accept or reject any non-compliant tenders without stating the reasons therefore and that the lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted. The Tenderer understands that fundamental to this competition is the selection of a tender that, in the Township's opinion, is in the best interest of the Township. To this end, the Tenderer agrees that the Township reserves the right to select a winning tender that may be non-compliant.
