Work will include but is not limited to operation of tandem axle dump trucks, graders, loaders including combination plow/wing units for winter road maintenance activities such as plowing, sanding, salting and snow and ice removal. Additional duties may include cold/hot asphalt patching, shop maintenance, roadside debris removal, road patrolling and various road and sidewalk maintenance activities.
