

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLETON**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 99-60**

Being a by-law to provide for reduced load limits on roads and / or highways in the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the Township of Mapleton.

**WHEREAS** subsection 7 of Section 122 of The Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.H.8, as amended provides that:

The municipal corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway may by by-law designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies;

**AND WHEREAS** the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of certain highways in The Corporation of the Township of Mapleton and therefore the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Mapleton enacts as follows:

1. The provisions of subsections 1,2, 3 and 4 of Section 122 of The Highway Traffic Act apply to the highways named hereunder during the period from the first day of March to the thirtieth day of April, inclusive in each and every year.
2. All roads and / or highways within the jurisdiction of The Corporation of the Township of Mapleton are subject to the reduced load limit during the period stated in Section One of this by-law.
3. The road reduction limit shall be a maximum of five thousand (5,000) kilograms per axle.
4. This by-law shall not become effective until appropriate signs have been erected and are on display.

Read a first and second time this 15<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1999.

Read a third time and finally passed this 15<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1999.
